Thanks to the advantages of China's system and the hard work of frontline workers, Wuhan Leishenshan and Huoshenshan hospitals were put into use within ten days; but from the start of construction to the official opening, it is difficult for the new beds of the two hospitals to match such a large increase in cases and stock situation. If more than 3,000 beds can be put into use at the beginning of the "closure of the city", "internal non-proliferation" will have more sufficient bed reserves as a guarantee. On the other hand, the insufficient reserves of masks, protective clothing and other materials have led to the front-line medical staff working without adequate protection, posing a potential threat to the key forces in the fight against the virus; at the same time, the shortage of daily protective materials has become a social hot spot The topic caused market chaos and mass panic.

4.3. Insufficient Reserves of Professional Teams, and the Accuracy of Personnel Classification Management is not High

For example, the professional medical team composed of infectious disease detection and treatment doctors was seriously overloaded in the early stage of the virus outbreak; the quarantine area team composed of necessary medical staff, security personnel, life management personnel and psychological counseling teams were not fully in place, resulting in The basic life and physical and mental health of the quarantined people cannot be guaranteed; the community task force composed of personnel responsible for community management, inspection records, information notification, material supply or other special services is not

fully operational, and it is difficult to ensure that the uninfected people can cooperate during the epidemic, support their work while ensuring their daily needs.

4.4. Insufficient Mobilization of Social Assistance Agencies and Forces

Since the emergency of the epidemic began, there has been a lot of public opinion about the Wuhan Red Cross Society in Wuhan, which has aroused public doubts about the officially designated organization to accept donations. On the one hand, from the refusal of CCTV reporters to live broadcast to the non-disclosure of the whereabouts of donations, it shows that there are serious problems in the working ability and attitude of the Wuhan Red Cross Society; The designated recipients of donations were announced on January 24, but unfavorable public opinion emerged within a few days, indicating that Wuhan's mobilization and supervision of these institutions has seriously lagged behind. At the same time, many self-organized epidemic prevention forces have emerged across the country and in Hubei, but the government has not timely unified social forces into the overall situation of epidemic prevention and control.

5. Reflections on Improvement under Chinese Management

From the perspective of general crisis management, in addition to improving the above shortcomings and deficiencies, some matters need to be institutionalized and normalized management, which is specially proposed here for further consideration.

5.1. Epidemic Control Should be Included in the Scope of National Management

Epidemic control is a major national event. In the era of globalization, it is even a global event, and it is not suitable for localized management. The localized structure and hierarchical management of administrative power are only for the purpose of effectively filtering information and organizing resources. It does not mean that the epidemic situation in a place should be controlled by the local government first. Any epidemic, even if it occurs in a remote village, should be regarded as a "national" matter, and should be included in the scope of unified national management, and the country will deploy forces and resources to deal with it.

5.2. Crisis Management Needs to Establish a "Professional Goalkeeper System"

In normal times, the country needs a few very important "gatekeepers", who use their professional knowledge, skills and judgment to look after the homeland of all the people and prevent various natural and man-made disasters from happening. Such "guards" can be institutions or individuals with certain positions, but they must have absolute professional authority. National security should establish a system of professional "gatekeepers": clarify their responsibilities, allow them to speak out according to their professional judgment, and give them the power channel and accountability mechanism to report to the highest decision-maker.

5.3. Responsibility and Cost Sharing System Should be Formulated for Crisis Management

Taking this war epidemic as an example, we should conduct in-depth research on the responsibility system for crisis management and control, and establish a national crisis management and control cost accounting and national sharing system. When a region of a country falls into disaster, it is a national disaster. Therefore, it is only natural that we should share the burden of national disasters. Establishing a crisis cost accounting and emergency cost sharing system is conducive to the unified deployment of national resources and ultimately helps to enhance national cohesion.

5.4. The State Should Formulate a Strategy for Material and Production Capacity Reserves

The war epidemic has warned that it is necessary to make a national strategic reserve of crisis response materials and production guarantees. The material and production guarantee strategic reserve plan should be laid out according to regional characteristics, and it should also be combined with regional development conditions to make it a new driving force for regional economic development. It is necessary to make full use of the high-efficiency characteristics of non-public enterprises to make them a material production and reserve enterprise, to ensure the supply of materials, to achieve civilian production in peacetime, and to switch production in time during wartime.

5.5. Design the Governance System and Build the Emergency Management System with the City as the Center

Many lessons can be learned from this epidemic prevention and control, such as how to avoid various "runs" or "snap buying" caused by general fear among citizens; The situation of ineffective management and no one is responsible; how to maintain the normal operation of the basic functions of the city; how to realize the timely conversion of enterprises and overcome the shortage of urgently needed supplies, etc. As far as the urban modernization governance system and governance capabilities are concerned, the sudden outbreak of the epidemic has exposed the shortage of disease control centers, infectious disease hospitals, medical staff, and hospital anti-epidemic material reserves. This must be considered in future urban governance. At the same time, in urban construction, in order to achieve the functional diversity of some urban buildings, they can be adjusted appropriately according to the needs at any time to give full play to their potential functions, instead of rushing to find a place to build in a hurry after the outbreak.

5.6. To Comprehensively Improve the Governance Capacity of Grassroots Society

There are two main aspects to determine the ability of grassroots governance: on the one hand, material factors, such as the material construction of the disease control center, epidemic prevention center, and medical center, must have reserves. Even if there is no reserve, it must be realized within 24 hours or sooner. Within a short period of time, it can be transformed into equivalent material conditions immediately. Another aspect is management ability. For example, when we have to carry out home isolation, there must be a team in the community management, which can satisfy many functions at the same time, including management isolation, test records, special services, etc., so that no special situation will occur. At that time, the common people "cry every day should not be answered, and the earth will not work". The fundamental foothold of urban governance is at the grassroots level. Only by comprehensively strengthening grassroots construction and consolidating the foundation of grassroots governance can we continuously improve the ability and level of urban grassroots governance.
